### Academic Review – May 2021

This letter outlines the year end arrangements and how the Key Assessment Grade (KAG) 6 information will be shared. We have communicated the progress of KAG 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 in our previous communication with you. The grades for KAG 6 will be available on the student learner portal and Parent Advantage from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May.

Please note that KAG 6 is not the final assessed grade determined by the subject teacher under the OFQUAL guidance for summer results 2021 ([www.gov.uk/government/publications/awarding-qualifications-in-summer-2021](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/awarding-qualifications-in-summer-2021)) but part of the evidence that teachers will be using to determine grades. Feedback on KAG 6 will be given to all students by their teachers in the timetabled lessons as held previously.

All lessons will continue until the end of May, students should be present at all lessons in case further checks on learning or follow up information is required.

After the half term holiday, we will organise individual appointments with Year 13 students to give further career guidance and harness progression routes as necessary. Students will not be required at the college at all times but for their appointments only; further information will be shared with students on how to book these appointments.

The official leaving date for Year 13 students will be **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2021**, clearance day to return books, other resources and college ID cards along with collecting refunds for locker keys will be **Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2021**.

Results days are: **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2021** for A level subjects  
**Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2021** for GCSE subjects  
Results will be available on the Learner Portal from 8am.

Please ring reception from 9am if you need to book an appointment with a Faculty Manager. This may be necessary if you have not been able to secure your destination in your chosen University.

Further information will be circulated to students and parents separately in line with the government guidance on enquiries relating to the final results.
