


#### **Getting to college is completely sorted!**

We have a dedicated bus from Ingleby Barwick and Acklam through to Stockton Sixth Form and back free of charge as well as a free bus pass to use right across the region when you want.

### **Making college** affordable for everyone

We believe money shouldn't be a barrier to your education, which is why we offer comprehensive financial support to help with the costs of college life.

If your household income is below £30,000, you could be eligible for our weekly subsistence bursary of up to £5 per timetabled day to help with lunches, drinks, and materials.

We also offer free transport support for all students, free meals for those on qualifying benefits, and digital access bursaries to help with broadband or mobile data.

For students in vulnerable circumstances - including those in care, care givers or those receiving certain benefits - additional support of up to £30 per week is available.

We can also help with essential equipment like calculators, art materials, and UCAS fees. Childcare support is available for young parents under 20, with payments of up to £180 per child per week.



### Food & drink

Our cafeteria offers healthy options at affordable prices, serving both hot and cold breakfast and lunch.

Students can choose from a wide selection of cooked meals, salads, sandwiches, and jacket potatoes. It's also a brilliant spot to grab a coffee and relax between lessons, making it a popular social hub.
